LIBERATOR GIN

A true Michigan original: Valentine Liberator Gin is named for the B-24 Liberator Heavy Bomber made in Detroit during World War II. Liberator is clear with aromas of peppery cinnamon, honey cardamom pastry, dried citrus, and candied juniper with a silky, dry-yet-fruity medium-to-full body. Earthy botanicals are macerated and infused for up to 48 hours, while lighter notes of citrus are imparted via a special vapor infusion process. Bottled at 42% ABV/84 proof.

HOW IT'S MADE

We hand select nine botanicals from around the world to create the singular Liberator flavor. The primary ingredients are juniper, cardamom, coriander, dried orange peel, and cinnamon, followed by orris root, grains of paradise, licorice root, lemon, and lime peel. Bold flavors are brought to life through a longer maceration process, while lighter notes are produced with a special botanical infusion method. Distilled from corn.

TASTING NOTES

Attractive aromas of peppery cinnamon, honey cardamom pastry, dried citrus, and candied juniper with a silky, dry-yet-fruity medium-to-full body and a zesty mélange of citrus, herbal roots, anise, pink peppercorn, and cinnamon bark on the long finish. A well-balanced and spice-forward gin for all applications.
