## **HOW IT'S MADE**

Mayor Pingree Red Label Bourbon is an age-stated, non-chill filtered blend of our choicest bourbon casks. The Red Label offers one of the highest-end straight bourbons produced by a craft distillery in the U.S. Exceptional barrels of our own Ferndale, MI triple pot-distilled bourbon meet the finest Lawrenceburg, IN traditional column-distilled bourbon casks to create a spirit with a silky, satisfying mouthfeel, intense fruit notes, and dramatic flavors that vary slightly from batch to batch.

## **TASTING NOTES**

The aroma varies slightly in accordance with the series, but often reveals notes of vanilla, toffee, oak, and nutmeg. Silky and wellbalanced on the palate, with a rich sweetness that lingers on the tongue. Flavors of caramel, chocolate, coffee, and a hint of smoke are common. The finish is warm and pleasant, and the aftertaste is sweet and slightly nutty.
